| Other specific requirements: | Halal butchery: all meat entering Iraq must be Halal. A certificate issued by an Islamic Organization or Council or any Accredited Body in the country of supply has to be provided certifying that the butchery has been done pursuant to the Islamic Shania regarding meat. The Entry Point Offices (EPO) of Bureau Veritas will check the CoC in order to make sure it matches import documents and matches with goods (when possible) and containers/trucks presented for clearance. The EPO may also be invited by Iraqi Customs, Iraqi Ministry of health or COSQC representatives to see opening/unloading of containers and trucks to check that the goods match what has been identified in the CoC. Upon Satisfactory completion of the inspection, the EPO will issue a Release note which will be provided together with the CoC to Customs to continue clearance process. |

- · Costs incurred by the exporter when presenting the goods for inspection and/or testing
- Supervision of loading and sealing of containers
- Audits
- Other expenses not mentioned above.
